McCleery Business Women's Golf Club Code of Conduct

The McCleery Business Women's Golf Club (the Club) takes great pride in ensuring our golf community is welcoming, respectful, and enjoyable for all members, guests, and staff, while upholding the integrity of the game. This Code of Conduct sets the standards of behavior expected of all members of the Club.

1. General Principles

- Treat fellow players, staff, and guests with **courtesy, respect, and fairness**.
- Contribute to an environment free of **harassment, discrimination, or inappropriate behavior**.
- Demonstrate **sportsmanship, honesty, and integrity** in all aspects of play and club interactions.

2. Starting Play

- Be at the first tee, ready to play, **at least 10 minutes before** scheduled tee time.
- **Introduce yourself** to the other members of your 4-some.
- **Exchange cards** for scoring and attestation.
- **Affirm specific play details** (e.g., who is in a competition, if gimmie putts are allowed, if winter rules apply).

3. On-Course Etiquette

- **Pace of Play** - Keep up with the group ahead, be prepared to play when it is your turn, and limit practice swings.
- **Respect for Others** - Avoid loud conversations, unnecessary movement, or distractions while others are playing.
- **Course Care** - Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers, and follow cart path rules.
- **Safety** - Ensure the area is clear before hitting, and shout "Fore" if a shot endangers others.

4. Competition and Fair Play

- Abide by the **Rules of Golf** and local club rules.
- Record scores honestly and fairly.
- Respect marshals and club officials, accepting their decisions without dispute.
- **Display good sportsmanship** - congratulate playing partners and opponents alike.

5. Safety and Well-Being

- Take responsibility for your personal safety, including hydration, sun protection, and safe use of carts.
- Refrain from excessive alcohol consumption or any behavior that endangers yourself or others.
- Report any unsafe or inappropriate behavior promptly to club management.

6. Mentorship and Community

- Encourage and support new members.
- Foster a positive and inclusive environment that builds confidence and enjoyment in the game.
- Participate in opportunities to mentor, volunteer, and contribute to women's golf events.

7. Breaches of the Code

- Breaches of this Code will be addressed by the Club Executive
- Depending on the nature of the breach, consequences may include:
 - Verbal or written warning
 - Temporary suspension from club events
 - Revocation of membership privileges
- Confidential reporting processes are in place to ensure safety and fairness.

By being part of the Club, all members agree to uphold this Code of Conduct and contribute to a respectful, safe, and enjoyable environment for all.
